Contemplate Lev Gillet's words of reflection found in his book, *"The Burning Bush"*:

"God is fire. God is love. God is a self-propagating emotional power, a fire that shares itself. Centuries after Moses beheld the flames of the burning bush, this same fire merged with the tongues of flame at Pentecost, and with the fire that burned within the hearts of the disciples at Emmaus. In saying that God is a fire of love we are certainly stating a truth that plays havoc with many of our ideas, in fact almost all our ideas."

Here are his thoughts concerning Moses speaking to God in the Burning Bush: "You ask what my name is. I am Being. I am the Being whom you see in being at this very moment. Look before you. You see the bush that burns without being consumed. You see fire. The Being I am is a Being of fire. These flames proclaim my love. But look more carefully. My fire does not destroy. That which it burns it purifies and transforms into itself, makes part of itself. And my flame has no need to be fed. It imparts itself, gives itself. I am the Gift that never ceases to give itself...I am Limitless Love.

THE FEAST OF THE MARTYR LONGINUS

This Friday, October 16th falls the Feast Day of Longinus whose memory is worthy of mention. The following is an excerpt taken from “The Prologue of Ochrid” which St. Nikolaj Velimirovich wrote about the holy martyr Longinus. He wrote, “The divine Matthew, the Evangelist in describing the Passion of the our Lord and God and Savior Jesus Christ says: Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, ‘Truly this was the Son of God’” (Matthew 27:54). That centurion was this blessed Longinus, who with two other of his soldiers came to believe in Jesus, the Son of God. He was chief of the soldiers who were present at the Crucifixion of the Lord on Golgotha, and was also the chief of the watch that guarded the tomb. him in peace. Due to the calumnies of the Jews, Pilate dispatched soldiers to behead him. St. Longinus foresaw in the spirit the approach of his executioners and went out to meet them. He brought them to his home, not telling them who he was. He was a good host to the soldiers, and soon they lay down to sleep. But St. Longinus stood up to pray, and prayed all night long, preparing himself for death. In the morning, he called his two companions to him, clothed himself in white burial clothes, and instructed the other members of his household to bury him on a particular small hill. He then went to the soldiers and told them that he was that Longinus whom they were seeking. The soldiers were perplexed and ashamed, and could not even contemplate beheading him, but he insisted that they fulfill the order of their superior. Thus, Longinus and his two companions were beheaded together. The soldiers took his head to Pilate, and he turned it over to the Jews. And history reports that they then threw it on a dung heap outside the city. He is as an example of a brave and courageous Christian man, something which is so needed in today's times.
